Effective December 1, 2006, the rules are as follows:

**Revision to Continuing Education Requirements 16 Tex. Admin. Code Ch. 76.250(b)**  
***“A licensee is to complete four hours of continuing education in Department-approved course to renew a license the CE hours must include one hour of instruction in Water Well Driller/Pump Installer statutes and rules, three hours of instruction in topics directly related to the water well industry.”***

**Revised Apprenticeship Requirements Effective December 1, 2006 Ch 76.205 (a)**  
***“Upon completion of a training program of at least two (2) years, an apprentice may apply to obtain a well driller’s and/or pump installer’s license or renew the status as an apprentice. Upon renewal of an apprentice registration, the supervising driller and/or pump installer shall provide the Department a written progress report on the training segments in 76.205(e)(3) pertaining to the apprentice’s stated training program. An apprentice must complete a one (1) hour department-approved continuing education course dedicated to the Water Well Driller/Pump Installer statutes and rules***

**“Water Well Driller/Pump Installer Statutes and Rules Course” Course #5897**

**“Submersible Trouble-Shooting” Course #5944**

For pump installers to better understand the critical need to match the well condition, to the need of the end-user, and choosing the best pump for the application. The dealer should better understand efficiency, water horsepower, flow requirements, material compatibility, etc. This course will also cover Cavitations, NPSH and Pipe Sizing. This course of instructions qualifies as credit for water well drillers and pump installers.
